Greetings in July,

This is normally the time of year when summer starts to take effect. The kids have been out of school and adjusted, the summer schedule is settling in, and all of the activities from baseball to softball to boating to camping to fishing to parades to just sitting outside and looking at fireflies and the crimson clouds of Iowa sunsets. This all seems to be happening, but with caution, with masks, with hand sanitizer, 6 feet away, and never feeling quite safe. During all this change God indeed remains a constant, an ever-present help in times of trouble.

Please join us for worship. We have a variety of options. We are doing social distanced services in the Sanctuary. You are strongly encouraged to stay 6 feet apart and if you can, please wear a mask. We also have live services on Facebook. They start at the regular time (9:15 a.m. on Sunday). They are available on Facebook any time. The parking lot is broadcasting the service with a FM transmitter in the parking lot...set to 107.9 F.M. We are also present on the YouTube channel of the church, as well as the website of the church ([zioninhumboldt.org](http://zioninhumboldt.org)).

We are also starting something new. We will begin broadcasting the worship services in the Fellowship Hall of the church for those who might want to be well socially distanced but prefer to be at church. The service is fed through the sound system of the fellowship hall and the live video feed can be viewed on the 80-inch TV in the Fellowship Hall. Tables and chairs will be set up...well over six feet apart. Please come and join us and sit in your family groups. Also, for those who attend the parking lot services, this would be another option, an air-conditioned option, for you.

There is a special voters meeting on July 12 to discuss and vote on calling Pastor Hansen. Pastor Hansen has been serving in our midst now for almost half a year and in accordance with the recommendations from the Iowa District West, Zion's call committee voted to extend a call to Pastor Hansen. The congregation will meet on July 12 to discuss and to vote on the call to Pastor Hansen. Details of the call will be provided at the meeting.

We are also going to, in limited fashion offer communion. On July 5 we will hold a communion service. Safety measures will be taken during the service including masks, hand sanitizer, and proper disposal (on the ground outside) of all the materials used. The elements will not be reused if not consumed during the service. The distribution will be done in the continuous line format like the contemporary service. We will be taking an informal poll on June 28 to see how many people might be interested in communing, so that we will have an estimate on how much to prepare beforehand.

The budget process begins soon. As well as the normal budget process, we are also beginning a discussion for hiring a youth worker. The committees of Zion are now resuming discussion on the recommendation from the annual meeting to call a youth worker and that will take place over the course of the next few months.

Going through things has stirred up many memories of the years gone by and how fortunate I have been to serve Zion as the director and teacher of the preschool for all of these years. Thank You.




## **FLOWER & LUTHERAN HOUR CHARTS**



## ZION LUTHERAN CHURCH COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES June 8, 2020

The June 8, 2020 meeting of Zion Lutheran Church Council was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by President Kent Stern. There were 9 members present. Pastor Aaron led the opening prayer. The minutes from the March 9, 2020 meeting and the Zoom meetings of April 27, May 11 and May 18 were approved as emailed.

Reports:

**Stewardship:** no report

**Education:** Dee Stern reported that May 15, 2020 was the official closing date of the Zion Lutheran Preschool. Laura and Barb will work through the summer cleaning out and distributing items that were used. Barb is checking with preschools that are opening and others to see if the items we have would be useful to them. Rally day in September will be Barb's recognition program. A card shower is planned for Laura. Sunday school will follow the public schools handling of classes.

**Evangelism:** no report

**LWML:** Jackie Schulze reported that LWML plans to hopefully start to meet again in September, if possible. Graduation gifts will be given to the graduates during the recognition service being held on Sunday, June 21. The confirmation banners are complete, just waiting to put the date of Confirmation on them.

**Elders:** Jim Gronbach reported that services will continue to follow state and synod guidelines. No timeframe for totally opening up the church has yet been set. They are looking into how communion can be done and will have a date for Confirmation set soon.

**Pastor Aaron:** Pastor Aaron reported that he did the funeral service for Colleen (Corky) Rosendahl at the funeral home. He is also working with the elders and parents on a plan for when confirmation can be held.

**MSC Pastor Hansen:** Pastor Hansen reported that he has not been able to work the 40 hours as agreed to since the Covid-19 pandemic and government shut down of our church. Marian Anderson made a motion to verify that, as a church council, we do not expect Pastor Hansen to use his allotted vacation time to cover the shortfall in his work hours. Dee Stern seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Being no further business, the council meeting was adjourned at 9:02 p.m. We closed with the Lord's Prayer.



On January 1, Molly Peaton and I started leading the Scrip Program for the Jr. LYC. We have steadily added new businesses and keep the book fully stocked so you can use your card – same day it is purchased.

Our cards and profits listed below:

Fareway – 3% - \$237.00

Floral Creations – 10% - \$20.00

Our project for the first six months is \$945.25. We are happy with this amount as the restaurants have not been open as well as no church services for half the period.

Some of you may still be wondering how we profit from this program. We order a \$100 card from HyVee for example. They give us 5% discount. We pay them \$95 for the card. You pay the Jr. LYC \$100, the value of the card.

This fall when everyone is back in church, we plan for the Jr. LYC kids to do more active selling and promoting of these cards. The profits all go toward their events and the youth gathering they attend. We are very thankful for those who have been faithfully buying the cards and supporting our local businesses and the students. If you haven't been using these cards please consider it. I personally have a hard time writing checks in the store when I can help the youth and have the same value of groceries I buy. It's a happy feeling.


